

# fire bellied bombina toad care sheet



## habitat

5 gallon terrarium or "critter-keeper" with secure lid. Hiding areas consisting of bark and branches. Coconut fiber or other soil-like substrate (Advised not to use mulch/wood chips because they might get stuck in the frog's throat when eating). Use a water bowl for toad to submerge in. Add dechlorinated water. Soil should be moist, not wet. A canister filter is needed to keep the habitat clean.



## lighting

They do not require lighting or heater.



## temperature

Room temperature is fine but ideally should range from 65°F to 72°F. Temperatures 82°F or higher is dangerous. Mist daily. Keep environment moist.



## diet

Live gut-loaded crickets and worms. Sprinkle food with calcium daily and with a mineral supplement once or twice a week.
